- *This will bring you to the Oasis gift registry with over 2,500 items.

Once you select your item and put it in the cart, you will see that the registry is set up to send all items directly to Oasis (att: Wanda) at 59 Mill St. Paterson so be sure not to change that feature when checking out.

If you prefer to provide financial support rather than purchase a gift, you may do so by going to the church website and clicking on the drop-down tab labeled DONATE in the top right corner and from there you will see another drop down which will show you the OASIS Back to School Supply project. You can also send in a check to the church office and checks should be made payable to 1st Pres Caldwell and be sure to put in the memo section Oasis School Supplies. All monetary donations must be received no later than Aug 1 to allow us to shop on your behalf. The **last day to order from the registry will be Sunday August 4** to provide enough time to process & ship your items to Oasis for distribution.

This year we are offering a "hybrid" collection so you may either order items online at Amazon or purchase an item from the attached supply list and drop it off in the collection box at church located in front of the Christian Ed Desk
