6. As with all church related trips — no smoking, no alcohol, no drugs.

In a community based upon love, trust, and support, each participant is responsible for their own actions. If a member of the group demonstrates a lack of love and respect towards fellow team members (youth or adults), site supervisors or property, parents may be called to come and take you home.
